## **Background:**

Gram Samridhi Evam Swachhata Pakhwada from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2017 is an effort to make the local communities active partners in their own well being. It has two distinct components. The first component which centers around Gram Sabha meetings, cleanliness campaigns and public information on different schemes of the government would be implemented across all the Gram Panchayats. The second component would be implemented across 1108 Gram Panchayats selected for Mission Antyodaya programme. Various Ministries of Govt. of India would jointly work with the Ministry of Rural Development to take up the programmes. One of the major objectives of the Pakhwada is to encourage people in the village, to participate in Gram Sabha meetings and take up issues for development of their well being.

The following have been designated by the Rural Development for liasoning with GoI, coordination, monitoring, reporting etc of this programme:-

### 1. **Appointment of Nodal Officer**

To review the governance, a questionnaire has been developed by the Ministry. There will be one Block Level Nodal Officer and one Gram Panchayat Level Nodal Officer appointed by the District Nodal Officer for each GP for this programme. The GP level Nodal Officer will conduct PRI Committees meeting and will do the documentation and upload the information on GoI portal through mobile application after getting vetted from the Gram Sabha or their standing committee for better implementation of the GPDP.

All the concerned departments should appoint Nodal Officers of their department for the celebration of the Pakhwada who will join the core team with the State Level Nodal Officers of the Rural Development Department for the implementation of

strategy for the Pakhwada. They can visit the field during this period alongwith the officials of the GoI. The concerned departments will provide the details of Nodal Officers of their department, action plan for the pakhwada for consolidating and uploading it to the Ministry's portal.

**Action to be taken: By all the concerned departments & Administrative Secretaries (upto 14.9.2017)**

## **2. IEC Activities**

A State level intensive campaign is to be conducted in all the Gram Panchayat for making aware the village people about the programmes/schemes implemented by various departments and to motivate them for their proactive role in the Gram Sabha. For this purpose, IEC activities by placing hoardings, wall paintings, radio, FM, SMS, posters, Nukkad Nataks, movie clips and other such folk media is to be used before 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2017 so that the village people may be motivated to participate in the Gram Sabha meetings to be convened on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2017 (Gandhi Jayanti). The sample IEC material received from the Ministry has already been sent to the concerned departments and District Nodal Officers.

Comprehensive PIS or *Janta MIS* by painting public walls to display the village performance indicators, displaying beneficiary list of various government schemes, list of works done as per GPDP or from the funds like MGNREGA, PMAYG, 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission on Gram Panchayat walls, etc. to be done.

**Action to be taken: By concerned departments & DCs (28.9.2017 to 30.9.2017)**

## **3. Cleanliness campaigns**

### **(i) Information and flagging off Cleanliness campaigns:**

The PRI, VRP, CRP, Patwaris, GRS, ANM, ASHA, ICDS, women SHGs and school children will be movers of this campaign will be PRIs and CRPs. They will provide the people general information about the campaign, motivate participation in Gram Sabha and flag off the sanitation campaign.

The elected representatives can be invited to motivate the public and participate in the campaign.

**Action to be taken : By PRIs, Panchayats Department and DCs (1<sup>st</sup> October, 2017)**

### **(ii) Gram Sabha:**

Gram Sabhas will be organized in all the GPs on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2017.

- i) Prabhat Feris during morning and organizing Bal Sabhas by involving school children, in coordination with School Education Department.

- ii) Organizing Bal Sabha by VOs for cleanliness awareness.
- iii) In Gram Sabha- Presentation of overall works taken in last FY and first 6 months of current FY, GPDP review, sanitation status, Health & Education needs and base line ranking process under Mission Antyodya to be done by the GP Level Nodal Officer.
- iv) Conducting Gram Panchayats Council Meetings
- v) Preparing roadmap for Clean Green Villages and Gram Samridhi by the Gram Sabha.
- vi) Resolution to make garbage & polythene free village.
- vii) Cultural Programmes like Film shows, Street Plays etc. in the evening by the Public Relations and Cultural Affairs Departments.
- viii) Presenting the observations of the Social Audit if conducted by the resource persons.
- ix) Updating job cards, nominating 2-3 women SHGs as VRP, putting up citizen information board and formulating draft plan of MGNREGA for the financial year 2018-19 with the help of technical resource persons.
- x) Display information and plan about water conservation and natural resources
- xi) Announcing the permanent wait list of PMAY-G beneficiaries before Gram Sabha, display of the village wise list of the same in the GP bhawan through wall writing, flex boards etc.
- xii) Display of flexes showing PMAY-G program features.
- xiii) Display of information about the scheme of NSAP, eligibility criteria and beneficiary lists.
- xiv) To sensitize villagers/beneficiaries about entitlements of National Food Security Act [NFSA] on the following issues:
  - i. Entitlements of food grains (total food grains entitlement per family/per person) for AAY/PHH beneficiaries.
  - ii. Scale of issue (Share of wheat and rice in total entitlement).
  - iii. Retail issue prices.
  - iv. Tentative time by which the monthly food grains allocation is received by FPS dealers for purpose of distribution.
  - v. People should be made aware of the Grievance Redressal Mechanism including the name, address, e-mail and tel. no. of District Grievance Redressal Officer and contact detail of State Food Commission.
  - vi. Toll free telephone number to be given wide publicity
  - vii. FPS related records to be placed in gram sabha for inspection by public
  - viii. Explain benefits of Aadhaar Seeding of Ration Card and Mobile Seeding of beneficiary.
- xv) Beneficiary list to be readout in the Gram Sabha.
- xvi) Benefit of solar lightening system be made in Gram Sabha.

- xvii) The already approved ICAP of RURBAN should be shared with the villagers and report card of works done in older clusters should be put up before the Gram Sabhas.
- xviii) Filling up of the format provided by MoRD with geo-tag photographs and getting vetted in the Gram Sabha by the Panchayats Secretary.

**Action to be taken: By the School Education, Panchayats Department, Rural Development Department, Public Relations and Cultural Affairs, Social Justice & Empowerment, Food and Supplies Departments, HAREDA, other Deptts. and DCs on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2017.**

**(iii) Clean and Green Village:-**

The PRIs and SHGs of HSRLM, Horticulture, IWMP, ICDS, Forest, ASHA, ANM etc. should be involved in the following activities:

**a) Sanitation Drive in houses**

- i) A pledge on cleanliness, ban on the use of plastics, keeping the village clean, use of toilets/IHHL, maintenance of the toilets etc. is to be taken.
- ii) Cleanliness drive in their own houses, vicinity of houses and immediate neighborhood and maintenance of toilets. Keeping the village clean.
- iii) People should be motivated to take up cleaning of drains, removing the garbage from the shoulders of the roads and identifying a spot for garbage disposal.

**Action to be taken : By Panchayats Deptt. & HSRLM, IWMP, WCD, Forest, Health ,Forest Deptt & DCs on 3<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**b) Food Nutrition & Health Hygiene**

Awareness campaign on Swachata (Cleanliness), Swasthya (Wellness), Poshan (Nutrition) etc. with the support of IEC materials.

- i) Play films on FNHW (Food Nutrition Health and Wellness).
- ii) Promote Behavior Change: Use of Toilets, Hand Washing at critical times, Food Hygiene, Menstrual Hygiene.
- iii) Awareness on WASH related issues will be organized.

**Action to be taken : By Health Deptt., Panchayats Deptt., HSRLM & DCs on 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

### **c) Sanitation Motivation in Schools**

- i) Parallel activities in schools on specific themes including Swachhta may be undertaken in the form of painting/elocution competitions etc. which may ultimately culminate in final prize distributions.
- ii) Organizing one-day Children's Assembly in the village by Village Organizer on Swachata, Swastya, Poshan and SLWM along with making them responsible for keeping the village as ODF. Conducting competitions for developing posters, elocution, etc on Sanitation Health and Nutrition.
- iii) Cleaning of schools/plantation of trees in school.

**Action to be taken : By ICDS, School Education, Panchayats Deptt. & DCs on 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

### **d) Health Camps**

- i) Weighing Children in ICDS centers.
- ii) Health checkup of children in schools.
- iii) Awareness on malnutrition in ICDS centers, schools etc.
- iv) Female & infants health checkup camps.
- v) Health camps alongwith FNHW.
- vi) To make the village green, the plantation in village be done

**Action to be taken : By Health Deptt., Forest Deptt., Panchayats Deptt. & DCs on 6<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

### **e) Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY)**

Under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), the aim would be to maintain, upkeep and clean PMGSY roads, road furniture and bridges and culverts by undertaking an intensive drive from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2017. This drive would ensure that PMGSY road contractors, State agencies (SRRDAs and PIUs) and local communities are sensitized regarding proper maintenance and cleanliness of these roads.

The following work items for routine maintenance would be executed in a campaign mode:

- i) Clearing/re-shaping of road side drains.
- ii) Pothole filling.
- iii) Filling up edges of asphalt surface.
- iv) Dressing of berms, earthwork on berms, rain cuts and dressing of earthen embankments, wherever necessary.

- v) Refixing displaced guard stones and white washing guard stones, parapets of cross- drainage (CD) works, etc.
- vi) Fixing and re-painting disturbed kilometre stones, caution boards, village sign boards, speed limit boards, PMGSY logo and citizen information boards.
- vii) White washing and geroo painting of trunks of trees on road flanks.
- viii) Cutting of branches of trees and shrubs which are obstructing flow of traffic and line of sight.
- ix) Maintenance of catch water drains as well as clearance and desilting of cross drainage works.
- x) Demonstrate the use of mobile apps in digitally connected/advanced villages.
- xi) Reporting of all activities taken up during the campaign will be done on ooms.nic.in
- xii) Cleaning repairing/maintenance of internal village roads and roadsides, identifying a spot for garbage disposal, construction.

**Action to be taken : By Panchayats & PWD(B&R), Public Health, Engineering Deptt. & DCs on 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**(iv) Krishi Sabha and Public Information**

Gram Panchayats in consultation with the Krishi Vigyan Kendras/Agriculture Extension workers to explain the importance of convergence for improving productivity and diversified livelihood opportunities as per following activities:-

- i) Awareness of latest techniques of agriculture and improved variety of seeds.
- ii) Promotion of Dairy, Poultry, Pisciculture as additional source of income through convergence
- iii) Formation of producer companies.

**Action to be taken: By Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry, Fisheries, Panchayats Departments & DCs on 8<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**Livelihoods**

- i) Special Mahila Sabhas/ SHG members meeting.
- ii) As part of sanitation drive vermi compost pits to be made.
- iii) Discussions on micro credit plan for the village.
- iv) Value chain development.

**Action to be taken: By Panchayats Departments, HSRLM & DCs on 9<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**(v) GPDP review and discussion about implementation:-**

Mapping with all resources and general public awareness for preparation of GPDP. The list of works done as per GPDP or from the funds like MGNREGA, PMAY-G, 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission and other Govt. scheme to be displayed and discussed for implementation.

**Action to be taken : By Panchayats Departments & DCs on 10<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**(vi) A) Preparation of MGNREGA Action Plan**

Reporting of MGNREGA alongwith photographs and formulation of shelf of projects to be finalized with the technical resource persons and facilitators in presence of all stakeholders and after getting approved from Gram Sabha.

**Action to be taken : By Panchayats and Rural Development Departments on 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**B) Special focus on Solid Liquid Waste Management (SLWM)**

The functionaries to endeavour the plan and execute SLWM projects besides maximum coverage of IHHL. The projects like waste to wealth (Kachre se kamai), vermi-composting using polythene for construction of road and other plans should be made.

**Action to be taken : By Panchayats Department & DCs on 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**C) Action Plan to lay emphasis on water conservation:-**

Various activities and awareness programme on mission water conservation and natural resource management is to be conducted. Action plan to be formulated.

**Action to be taken : By Agriculture Department, IWMP & DCs on 11<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**(vii) A) Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G):-**

- a) Public reading of the list of completed houses.
- b) Grih pravesh (house warming) for the completed houses and Bhoomi Poojan for new houses may be done ceremoniously in the concerned Gram Panchayat.



- c) Nukkad natak/skit based on housing scheme showcasing transparency in scheme implementation and saying no to corruption/middlemen.
- d) PMAY-G film screening
- f) SMS/Whatsapp messages against rent seeking must be sent to all PMAY beneficiaries.
- j) Sharing of success stories pertaining to benefits of E-Payment , AwaasSoft & AwaasApp, with the gathering.
- k) Q&A sessions with audience on scheme features.

**Action to be taken : By Rural Development Department, DPR & DCs on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**B) Verification of old-age and other pensions, scholarship:-**

- a) Gram Panchayat would be engaged to specifically carry out social audit as per the requirements of NASP guidelines.
- b) List prepared on the basis of SECC criteria will also be made available at gram panchayat level for cross verification with BPL beneficiaries with a view to clean up the list. This will enhance the preparedness for moving towards universalization of pension scheme based on SECC data.
- c) Verification from the beneficiaries whether payments are made on time.
- d) Identification of left out beneficiaries.

**Action to be taken : By Social Justice, Empowerment Department & DCs on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**C) Food distribution & LPG:-**

- a) Besides, a special drive is to be organized for enrolment and seeding of Aadhaar with ration Card and Mobile Seeding of beneficiaries. Gram sabha meetings must be utilized for explaining benefits of Aadhaar Seeding of Ration Card and Mobile Seeding of beneficiary.
- b) Public Participation in monitoring to be ensured by taking following measures:
- c) Special cleanliness drives to be organized for fair price shops.
- d) Vigilance committee meetings for Fair Price Shop be organized.

**Action to be taken : By Food & Supplies Department & DCs on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**(viii) Skill Development**

- a) Identify the rural youth who are interested in skilling for wage placement or self-employment.
- b) The States should use this opportunity to use the mobile app for mobilization of candidates who are interested in wage placement.
- c) Job fairs/mobilization camps should be organized with the support of Program Implementation Agencies (PIAs) and potential employers. Aptitude tests of candidates for suitable vocation may also be undertaken, to offer them a choice for enrolment in skilling in an area of their interest.
- d) Those who are interested in taking up self-employment should be registered for taking up training in RSETIs. The RSETI states directors and RSETI directors/ faculty should also be actively engaged during this campaign.
- e) A number of trainings are being conducted by RSETIs. Credit linkage camps should be organized in villages with bank branches so that significant number of loan cases pending for approval may be disbursed. Eligible cases must also be registered under PM Mudra scheme or other Government Schemes.
- f) Flagging off of 'Skill Raths' in the state with the mandate to visit every gram panchayat and build a database of job seekers/youth willing to participate in skill development programmes. The database will be shared with employers and training providers.
- g) Awareness programme on digital transactions and payments to be conducted with the participation of common service centres (CSCs), bank correspondents and other volunteers.
- h) Special drive may be taken to propagate and update the JAM (Jandhan Aadhaar Mobile) trinity.

**Action to be taken : By HSRLM and Skill Development & Industrial Training, E&IT, Lead Bank Manager, Panchayats Department & DCs on 13<sup>th</sup>-14<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

**9. Presentation on the Action Taken Reports (ATR):-**

Ministry has provided a reporting format to report on the performance of Gram Panchayat **Annexure I "Questionnaire for Gram Panchayat for survey"**. This should be filled up by the Gram Panchayat Nodal Officer and must be verified by Gram Sabha. The same has to be uploaded on the portal (<http://Swachhgram.nic.in>) of the Ministry. The reporting of various activities carried out by the Gram Sabha and Gram Panchayat are also required to be uploaded on the portal of the Ministry as per the detail mentioned in

**Annexure IV(4a to 4i).** The photographs and video clips of various events undertaken during this Pakhwada be also uploaded on daily basis through **SwachhGram** Mobile App. Ranking of the GPs will be done on the performance.

**Action to be taken :** **By Panchayats & Rural Development, HSRLM & DCs on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

#### **10. Awards**

The best performing GPs at the end of the campaign, especially on overall status of cleanliness and sanitation in the village as well as on clean and green initiatives will be awarded. The second category of awards could be in overall performance of GPs in terms of their GPDP process planning as well as execution including 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission and MGNREGA funds for the creation of assets.

**Action to be taken :** **By Panchayats & Rural Development & DCs on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

#### **11. Mission Antyodaya Gram Samridhi**

During the Pakhwada, specific activities will be performed in the selected Mission Antyodaya Gram Panchayats. The SHGs will play vital role in cleanliness campaign and health and nutrition assessments for this Pakhwada. The Gram Sabhas will be organized on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2017 (Gandhi Jayanti) for which high level IEC activities are to be conducted for all the running programmes/schemes and cleanliness campaign besides motivating village people to participate. The role of NRLM will be follows-

**1) SHGs/VOs will organize the celebration and conduct some programs in the following areas:**

- Sanitation drive in houses.
- Food Nutrition and Health Hygiene
- Sanitation motivation in schools
- Health camps
- Anti-plastic campaign and promoting the use of cloth bags and its production as a livelihood activity.
- One day will be celebrated as Aajeevika Swayam Sahayata Sangathan Diwas (SHG Day)

These activities will be reported in the format provided in the guideline with the GP level Nodal Officer for the Pakhwada.

**2) Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM):**

- All village organizations (VOs) will be actively involved in all intensive blocks along with SHGs.
- All SHG members will participate in the Gram Sabha scheduled during these days after necessary preparation of their needs and demands gathered during the VO Day.

- Active participation in the Mission Antyodaya Planning process.
- Preparation of base data on rights, entitlements and services from different schemes and programs.
- Awareness on Girls education- "Beti Bachao Beti Padhao".
- SRLMs may plan for activities to be taken up specifically in the respective states but with due importance to the activities mentioned here.
- Maintenance of registers for SHGs and for youths under DDU-GKY.
- Involve SHGs and students in taking feedback about the Mid-Day meal Scheme.

These activities will be reported in the format provided in the guideline with the GP level Nodal Officer for the Pakhwada.

## **12. Mission Antyodaya Survey:**

1108 GPs have been identified in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase of Mission Antyodaya in the State to bring out of the poverty. These GPs are to be benchmarked through a baseline survey in order to track their progress during the Pakhwada. During the period the village development plan and strategy for uplifting the sustainable Livelihood panchayat should be formulated and discussed. This will be carried out by the SRLM machinery with the help of a responsible person to be decided. A format has been design by the MoRD which is available on the web portal [www.missionantyodaya.nic.in](http://www.missionantyodaya.nic.in) and SamridhGram mobile app. The information collected will be uploaded on the app using GPS for authentication. The CEO, HSRLM is the State Nodal Officer of the survey and the detailed instructions regarding identification of resource person, training and strategies for the survey are available in Annexure-III of the guidelines of Mission Antyodaya Gram Samridhi Evam Swachhata Pakhwada.

**Action to be taken : By HSRLM, HIRD & Rural Development & DCs on 1<sup>st</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2017.**

## **13. Scoring & Ranking of GPs**

The information collected and uploaded on the portal will be placed before the standing committee of the Gram Panchayat for approval and thereafter will be finally submitted. The Govt. of India will rank the GPs.
